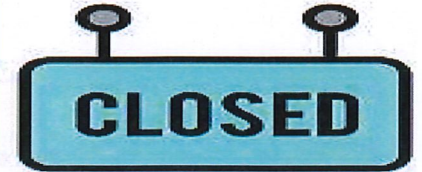
If you want your garden tilled for May long weekend, please call the office. All new gardens will have to be staked

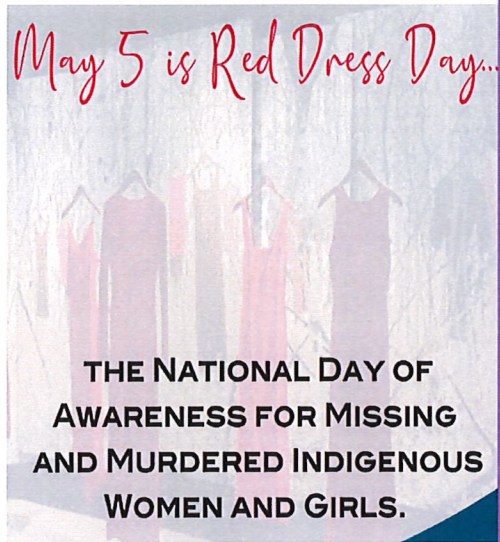

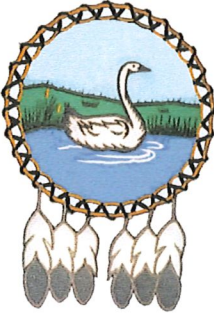
